 This calculator can be purchased through the school or at any supply store.
 A letter will be sent home explaining how to purchase one through the school.
- One durable folder
- Loose-leaf (in the binder)
- Math Workbook (provided by the school)

Classroom Procedures:


- Take your seat as soon as you walk into the room.
- Take out your homework from the day before.
- Copy down your homework assignment.
- Start the warm up activity right away.
- Class ends when I dismiss you. Please wait for me to give you the O.K. before you begin to pack up.

Classroom Rules: (The 5 P's)

- Be Punctual.
- Be Prepared with your homework and required supplies.
- Be **P**olite. Raise your hand to speak and listen to others when they are speaking.
- Be a Participant. Always give your best effort and don't be afraid to make mistakes.
- Perform the directions the first time they are given.
